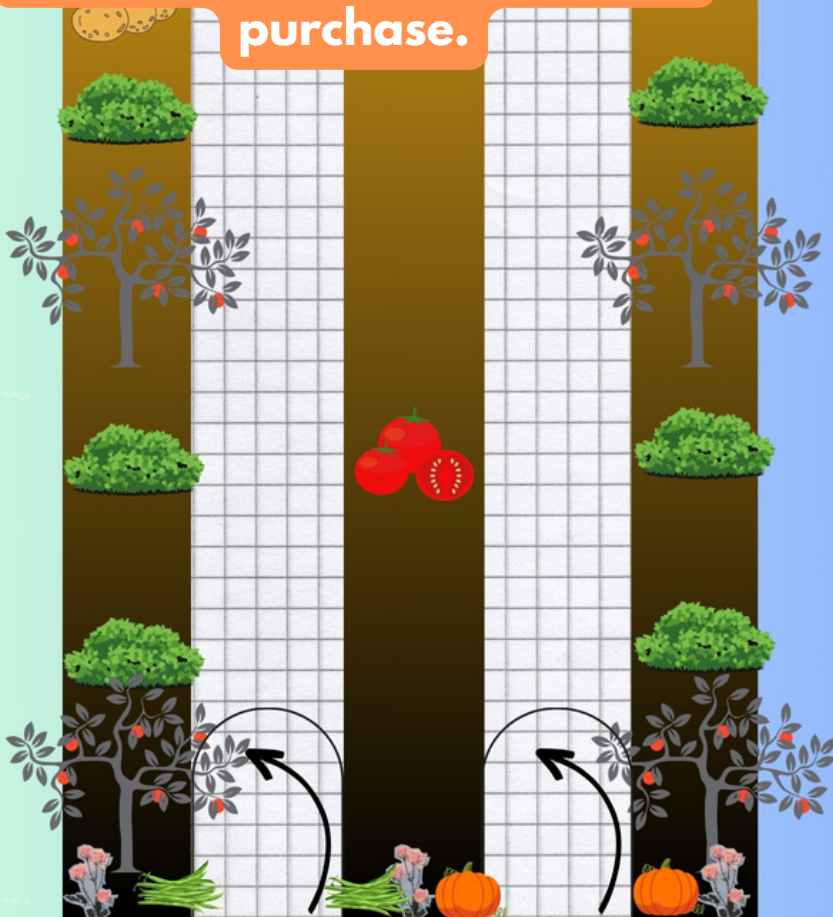


Trellis
